Key Factors in observing performance

- The key to good coaching is observation
- Unsuccessful coaches "too much interjection"
- Coaches can become dependent on coaching points, explanation, demonstration and perfection of each point
- This leads to a coach centred focus; 'I need to get my points across' instead of a player centred focus 'I need to analyse and address the needs of the players'





Key Factors

- 1. During the course we introduce "*Key Factors*" for each theme or topic

Key Factors

Key Factors can be broken down into four areas

- 1. Techniques
- 2. Skills
- 3. Tactics
- 4. Strategy
